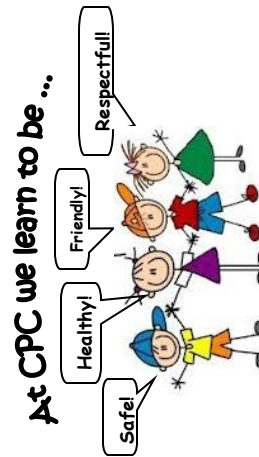

Our Philosophy

We believe that each child is a unique person of great worth, created by God & entrusted to us by parents to teach and love. Our approach to education is one that is concerned with the growth & development of the whole child: physical, emotional, social, intellectual & spiritual. We recognize that children learn best through play. We strive to provide an environment that is safe, loving, accepting & rich in opportunities for learning & growth through age appropriate, hands-on activities. We believe that appreciation of self & others is rooted in the knowledge of God's love & care for us. Therefore, we endeavor to help children: develop respectful relationships with others & appreciate differences & similarities; develop a love of learning & an appreciation of God's creation and love.

Our Outdoor Classroom

We are excited to offer an outdoor classroom for those who desire such an experience for their Pre-K children. In recent times, there is more and more concern for what is called Nature Deprived Children. Our Outdoor Classroom was created in response to this concern. It also comes out of a belief that the out-of-doors is a naturally nurturing place for children to learn and grow. All the experiences that children enjoy inside the classroom can be recreated outside with the added feature of using more natural items in their learning environment. These children do have approximately 45 min. indoors each day for those activities that are more conducive to an indoor environment.

- ◆ Develop strong social & emotional skills
- ◆ Develop pre-reading, pre-math & pre-writing skills
- ◆ Develop critical thinking, problem solving & listening skills
- ◆ Choice of an in-door or outdoor classroom
- ◆ Ratio is 2:16
